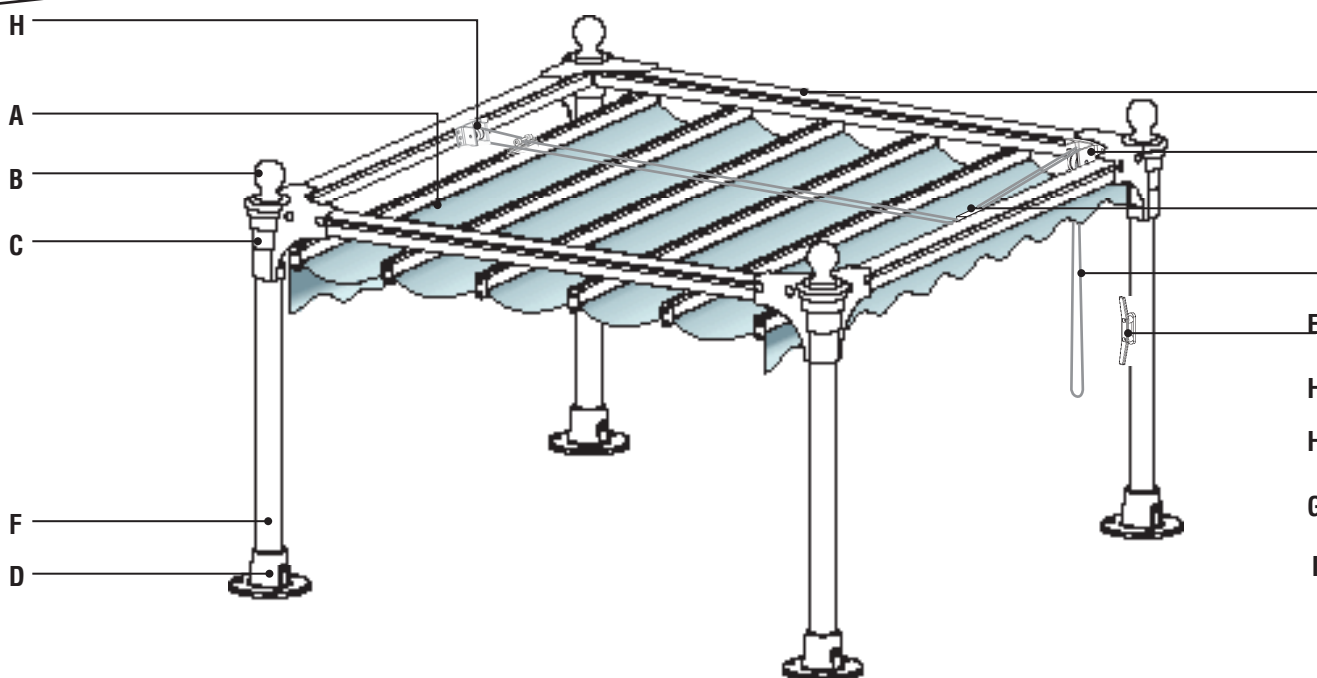


# Installation Notice

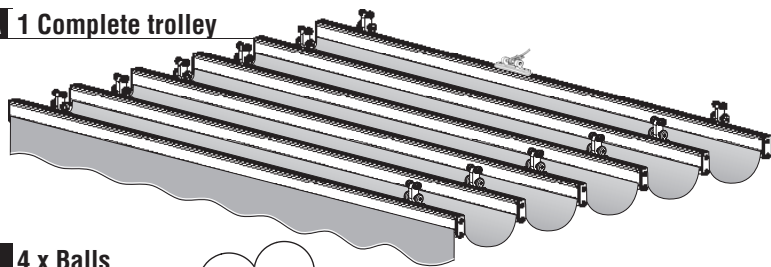
Be sure the surface where you install your pergola is completely flat.

If you have any doubt call a specialist

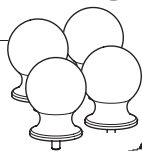

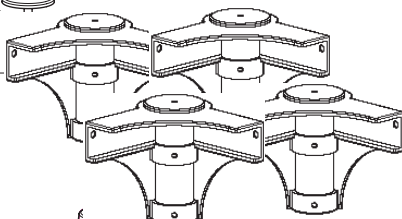
**A** 1 Complete trolley



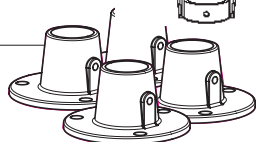
**B** 4 x Balls



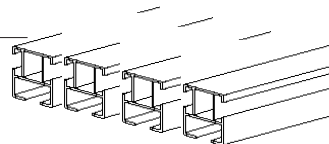
**C** 4 x corners

**E** 4 x profiles



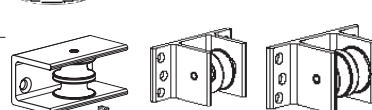
**F** 4 x tubes Ø50 mm

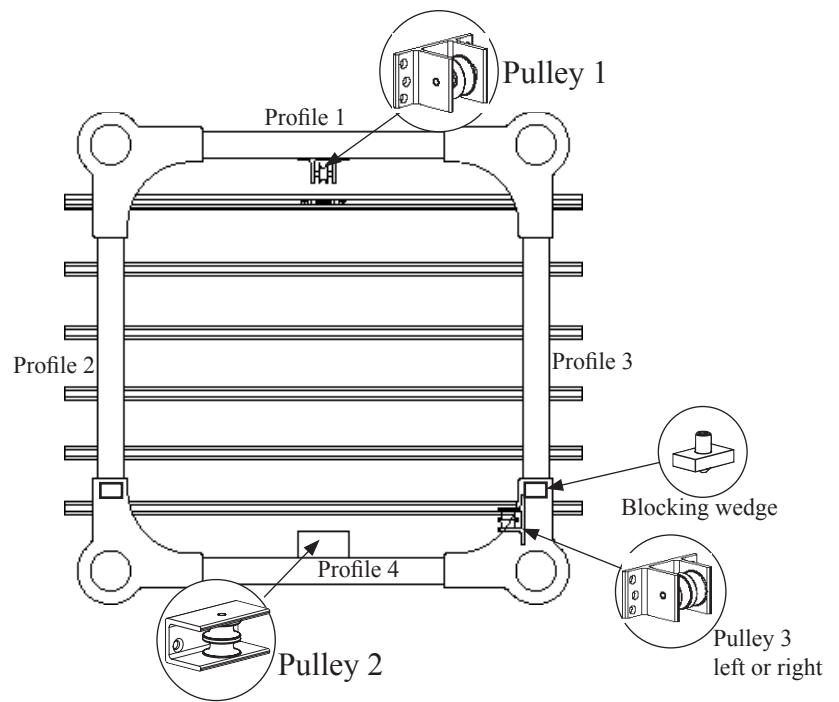

## PREPARATION

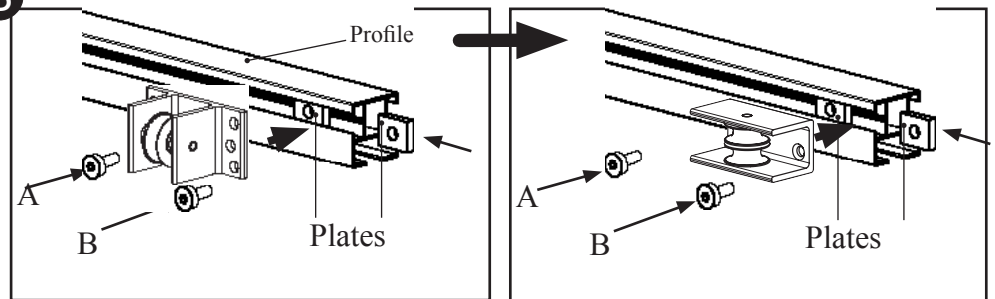
A

1/ Darg the 2 fixing plates in the profile with adequate placement.

2/ Place the pulleys and screw blocking ....using the key on the 6 sides.



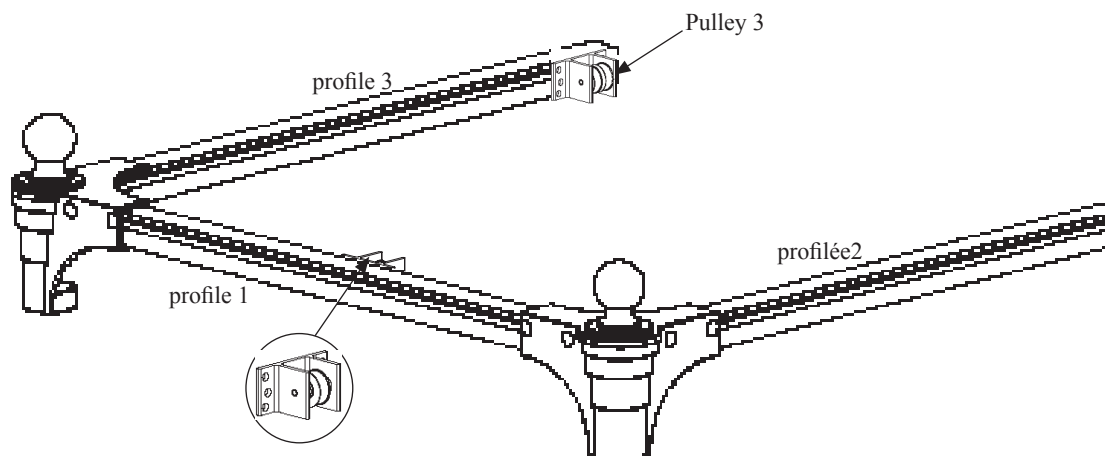
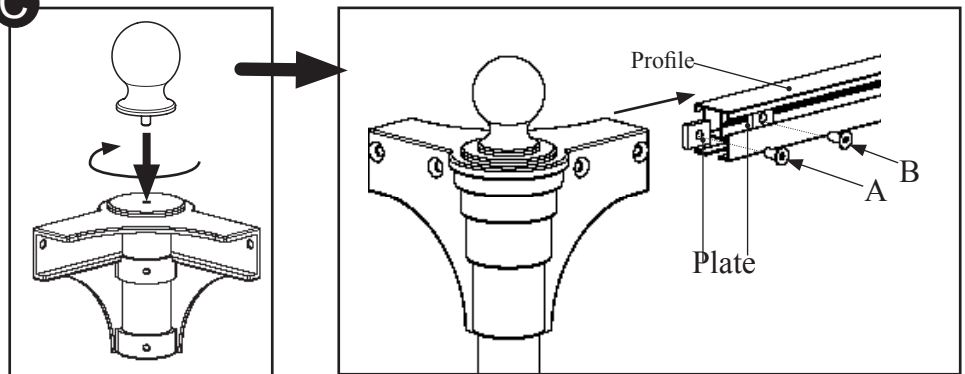

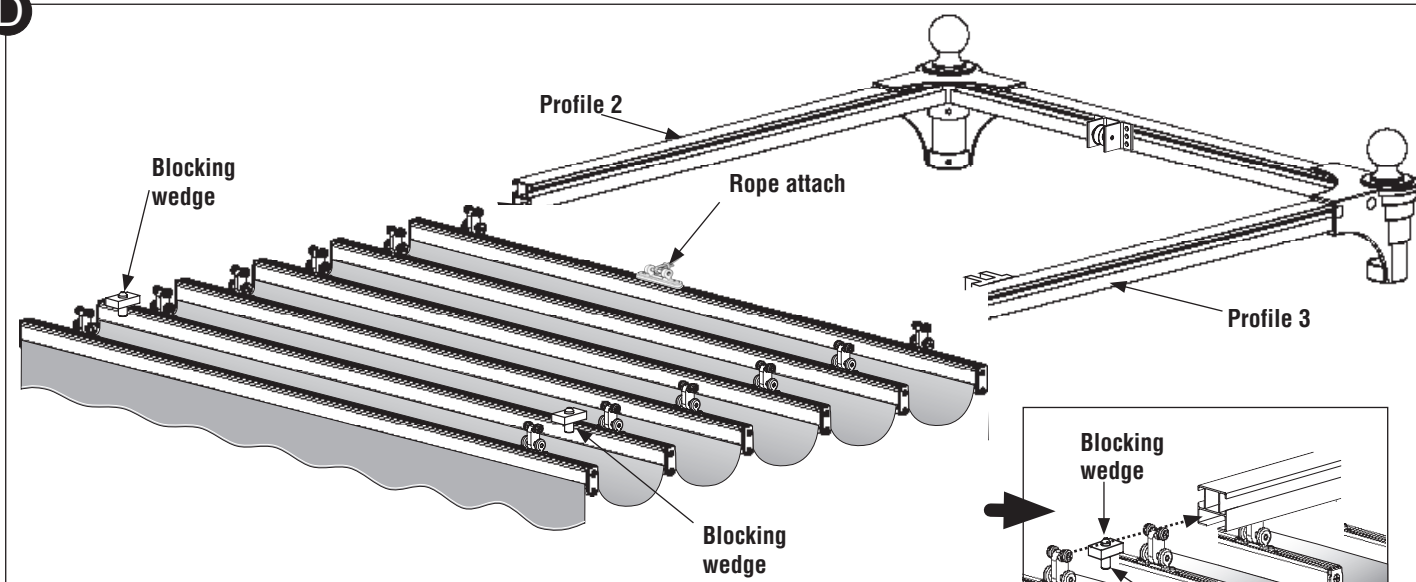

Before starting the installation attach the pulleys to the matching profile. (fig A). Otherwise your pergola won't work properly.

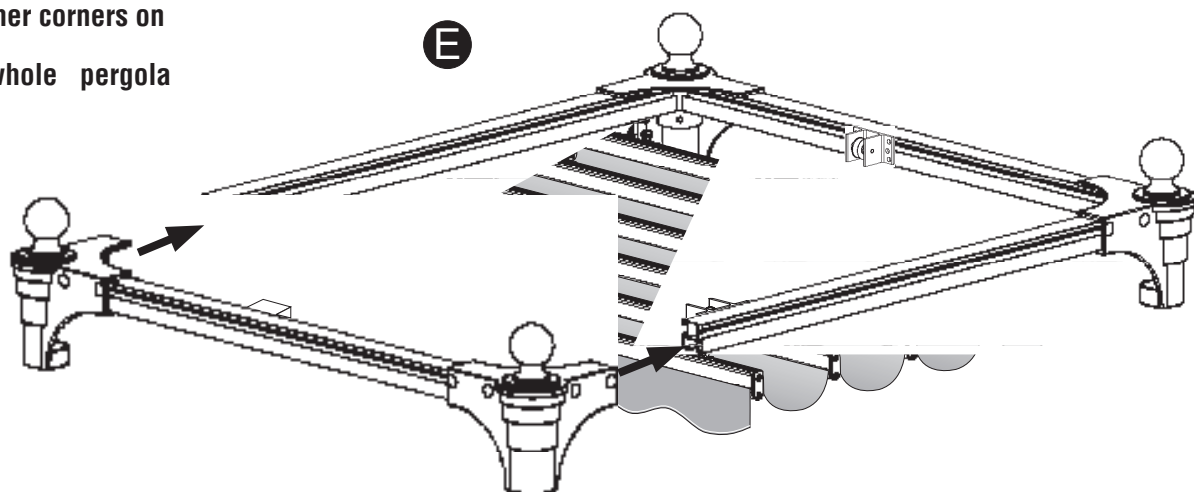
**D****3**

**IMPORTANT** slide de blocking wedge before the last trolley

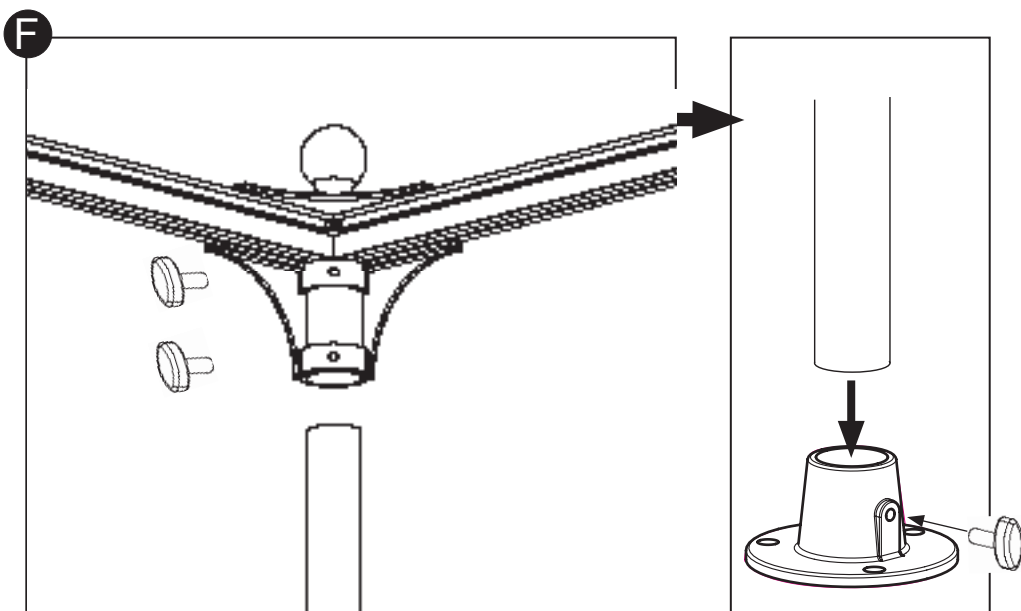
Slide the trolleys one by one in the profiles 2 and 3.

1/Installe the 2 other corners on the profile 4.  
2/ Attach the whole pergola together

1/ Lift the whole pergola and slide the tubes in the corner and tight the butterfly.  
2/ Slide the tube.



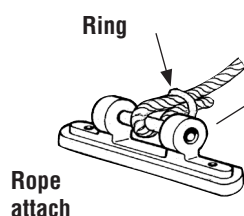

## Rope

**1/ Place the rope pulleys following the patch**

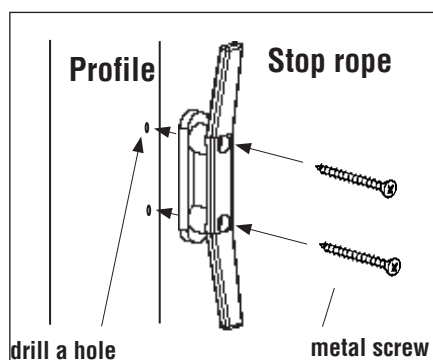
**2/ Attach the two extrimitees with rope and towers and pinch the claming rings.**

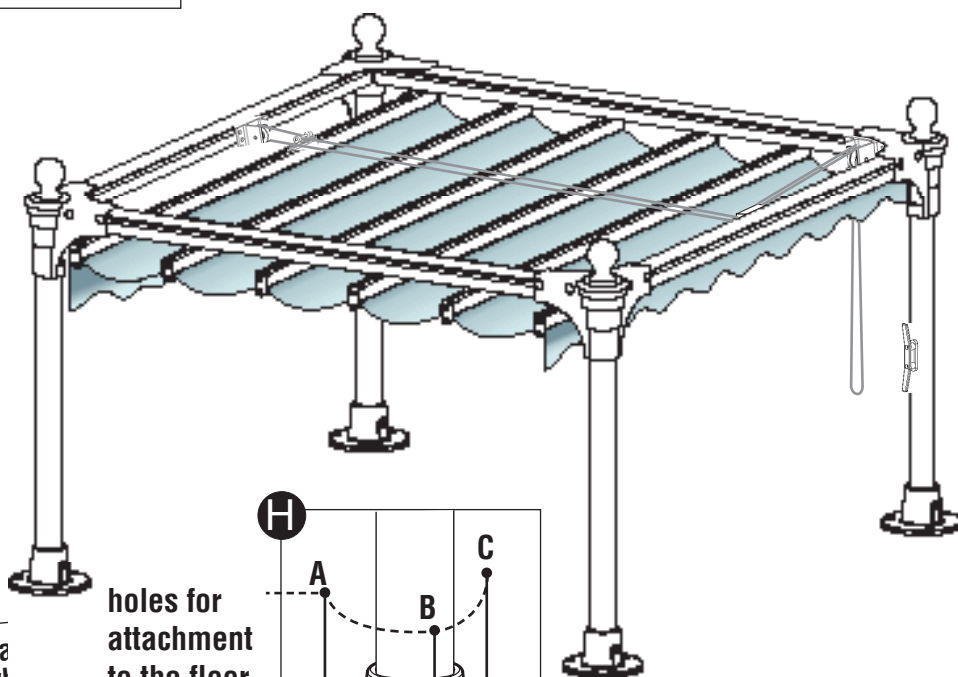
## Stoppage rope



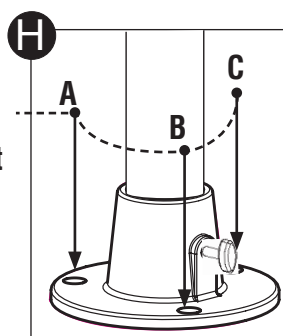

### Attachment to the floor

**Place screws on ground and adjust according to the type of soil for stability.**
